Applications are now open for grants from the newly established TLCC Community fund.

This fund has been set up to support community groups in the Lawrence-Tuapeka area. Funding is available for with projects that support the community, enhance the area or encourage tourism.

This fund has been set up using a donation from the now disestablished Tuapeka-Lawrence Community Company.

Funding requirements:

- Applications are open to formally established community groups in the Tuapeka-Lawrence area. Individuals are not eligible.
- Funding allocations are limited eligible community groups may be granted a maximum of one allocation each year.
- Funding applications must be for a specific project.
- Projects must clearly benefit the wider community, not only the group's members.
- Projects must support the community, enhance the area, or encourage tourism.


