#### DIG IT!

Gardening Tips for the locals

Welcome to our new fortnightly garden section. We hope the tips are helpful and make a difference in your garden!

Happy Gardening!

What a dreadful wet Spring we are having - so it is not a good idea to work the soil when so wet - you do more damage to the structure than good - also try not to walk on the soil as you will only compress it. Narcissus are beginning to set seedheads after flowering - cut these off to encourage the energy of the bulbs into the leaves where they get nutrients for bulb growth for next years flowering.

Peonies are showing a lot of growth. Stake up larger clumps as the heavy buds will take the flowers onto the ground. Lilies are showing growth also - stake if necessary. There is a great array of lilies available and they make a majestic show worth growing.

Another plant flowering now are Anemone nemarosa and Phlox - both forming matts of soft and bright colour. Both enjoy moistish conditions and partial shade. A.nemarosa (white, blue, pink, lavenda, yellow lemon) is wonderful under shrubs and will quietly form a matt of twiggy roots and loves leafmould. Phlox is matt forming also with colours bright purple, blue, crimson, white etc - great ground covers and can be trimmed back after flowering to keep neat. Enjoy your garden.

Council is seeking feedback on options for Milton's Bruce Community Facility, with the consultation period commencing on Monday, 23 September 2024.

We have two options and are asking which is your preferred one:

- Option 1: Creating a community library and pool facility that includes a six lane swimming pool at cost of \$19.4M;
- Option 2: Stop the project and determine the current financial structural needs of both the existing library and swimming pool, along with a cost benefit analysis to decide on what future investment will be viable to action into current sites.

A combination of Council and community funding is being considered for Option 1 and would impact all ratepayers in the Clutha District, and in particular those in the Bruce Community Facilities rating area.


